Grant-in-lieu of Provincial Property Tax	The purpose of the grant is to contribute towards providing fire protection services to provincial properties not otherwise subject to payment of a grant-in-lieu of property taxes. If they do not qualify for a Grant-In-Lieu of Property Taxes, they can apply for this grant.
