The Department of Municipal Affairs (DMA) administers the SCF, including the application process, on behalf of Canada and Nova Scotia. This 10-year cost-shared program (2014-2024) will provide \$42.6M in federal funding for capital infrastructure projects to be matched by provincial and municipal funds.</p>	<p>Eligible applicants under SCF include Nova Scotia municipalities and villages with a population under 100,000.
