Bursaries are awarded on a competitive basis, and due to limited funds, CMA cannot guarantee approval of your application. Applications for all types of bursaries will be judged on the following criteria:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> •The applicant's past achievements and demonstrated competence. •The eligibility or relevance of the proposed event to museum studies. •The relevancy of the proposal to the applicant's professional development. •The applicant's ability to carry out the professional development activity. •Applicants must be Canadian citizens, or have held landed immigrant status for 12 months prior to the application deadline. <p>Application note: You must apply for a bursary BEFORE the event you are planning to attend.</p>	<p>Application note: You must apply for a bursary BEFORE the event you are planning to attend.
