Activities can include language classes, Gaelic immersion, workshops and other cultural initiatives. There is two parts to this funding initiative.</p> <p>Priority 1: Increase immersion opportunities to learn and speak Gaelic. Funding allocated under this priority would not normally exceed \$5,000 per project or initiative.</p> <p>Priority 2: Increase awareness, involvement and interest in Gaelic language and culture.</p>	<p>An eligible applicant is a non-profit community organization within Nova Scotia that is registered as joint stocks entity with the Registry of Joint Stock Companies.</p>	<p>Applicants are strongly encouraged to contact the Community Development Officer directly to discuss their proposed activity before completing the application form.</p> <p><a href="http://gaelic.novascotia.ca/work">http://gaelic.novascotia.ca/work</a></p>	<p>Application due dates: 15 June and 15 November</p>	<p>Funding awarded will not normally exceed 75 per cent of eligible costs. The organization's contribution of 25 per cent can include approved in-kind costs, but must include at least a 10 percent cash contribution. The applicant's 25 percent contribution cannot include funding from other provincial or federal government departments.</p>	<p>This program assists non-profit organizations with projects to increase opportunities for people to learn and speak Gaelic and promote greater interest and involvement in Gaelic language and culture.
