Aboriginal Peoples Program (2 Types of Funding)	<p>The Aboriginal Peoples' Program promotes Indigenous languages, strengthens cultural identity and increases Indigenous participation in Canadian society. The APP offers two funding components to eligible Indigenous organizations:</p> <p><b>1) Aboriginal Languages Initiative:</b> The Aboriginal Languages Initiative (ALI) supports the preservation and revitalization of Indigenous languages through community-based projects and activities.
