TAX REBATE - Heritage Property Conservation Material	Service Nova Scotia offers a Provincial Tax Rebate (under the Sales Tax Act). Heritage property owners are eligible for a full rebate of the provincial sales tax paid for materials used on the exterior of the building.	The purchaser of the building materials is the only party entitled to a rebate.
