The Fund is a collaboration between Canada's community foundations, the Government of Canada, and extraordinary leaders from across the country. The Fund is based on grassroots leadership, and will take on a local focus and timeline in each community.</p> | <p>The Community Fund for Canada's 150th is available to qualified donees operating within Canada, with the exception of the federal, provincial, and territorial governments; the United Nations, and the Crown. Community groups and other actors are welcome to work with a qualified donee to make an application to the Fund.</p> <p>In the case of such a collaboration, the qualified donee would submit the application and act as a fiscal agent on behalf of the collaborating parties. Check the Canada Revenue Agency Charities Listing, and List of Other Qualified Donees to find potential partners in your community – they may be interested in collaborating on your project!</p> | <p>How do I apply?
