Application Deadline: June 15

FCM is now accepting applications for its Climate and Asset Management Network. This new network will provide peer-learning opportunities, grant funding and training to help municipalities better integrate climate and sustainability goals into asset management approaches.

As a network participant, you can benefit from funding of up to \$175,000 for your municipality along with workshops and knowledge-sharing activities with colleagues from municipalities across Canada.

The network is designed for municipalities that are taking action on climate change and want to better integrate climate change goals with decision-making about infrastructure assets and services, such as roads, buildings, drinking water and sanitation.

The deadline for applications is June 15.

The Climate and Asset Management Network is offered through FCM's Municipalities for Climate Innovation Program and funded by the Government of Canada.
